I am writing to advise you that our contractor Cambridgeshire Highways, will commence carriageway patching and preparation works of the A605 Eastrea Road, Whittlesey on Wednesday 20th May 2020, in advance of carriageway Surface Treatment in 2020.

Works are anticipated to last 3 nights, and whilst the work is in progress, during operational hours, the road will be closed from 8pm to 6am between Cemetery Road and Dandelion Drive; and vehicular access will be restricted. A signed diversion route will be in place for through traffic.

Access to properties within the closure area will be possible, but are subject to working conditions, and delays are to be expected. Our contractor will be working under their Covid 19 Risk Assessments and Method Statements. As a result of these new working approaches, it will no longer be possible to carry out advanced warning letter drops to properties. However, advanced warning signage will be out on all roads 14 days in advance of the commencement of works.
