Important roadworks information

Dear Sir/Madam

A47 Chapel Lane to Redmoor roundabout: resurfacing

I write to inform you that we will be carrying out essential resurfacing works at the above location.

We plan to complete this work over **two nights** from **Monday 22 June** to **Wednesday 24 June**, working between the hours of **8pm to 6am**, subject to weather conditions.

We have liaised closely with the local authority within the area, to agree the most suitable route for the closure as detailed below:

A47 between Guyhirn roundabout and Redmoor roundabout closed in both directions, starting Monday 22 June to Wednesday 24 June (two nights)

- Northbound traffic will be diverted via the A47 / Guyhirn roundabout onto the A141 / March Road and Wisbech Road, along the B1099 / Wisbech Road and Dartford Road, to the B1101 / Station Road, Elm Road and High Road and onto the A1101 / Elm High Road before re-joining the A47 at the Elm High Road / A47 roundabout.
- Southbound traffic will be diverted via the A1101 / Elm High Road, onto the B1101 / High Road, Elm Road and Station Road, along the B1099 / Dartford Road and Wisbech Road, to the A141 / Wisbech Road and March Road before rejoining the A47 at Guyhirn roundabout.

We have included the diversion map for this closure at the end of this letter. (Diagram 1)

Access and disruption

Access for emergency vehicles will be allowed at all times. For residents living within the road closure, access to and from your property will be through Guyhirn roundabout. A member of our team will be stationed at this location, please show this letter so they know that you are a resident wanting access to your property, we advise that you keep a copy of this letter in your vehicle. Please follow the instructions of our site team who will take measures to ensure the safety of both you and our workers on site.

COVID-19

Please be assured that all our sites have strict safeguarding measures to prevent the spread of COVID19 and none of our sites are open to the public. We will be carrying out all works following safety guidelines set by the Government.


