### **COVID-19 Community Hub**

I would like to remind all Fenland residents of the help available to them should they need it during the second national lockdown.

Our COVID-19 Community Hub was set up during the first lockdown to coordinate help and support throughout the district to ensure the most vulnerable members of the community can access critical support as soon as they need it. This includes those told to self-isolate, the over 60's, those who fall within the vulnerable groups listed by the Government and anyone who needs access to support as a result of being impacted by COVID-19.

We are currently seeing a rise in cases in Fenland in the 60+ age range. To help stop the spread of COVID, we would urge you to:

- Reduce the risk and stay at home as much as possible
- Reduce the risk and only go out for essential shopping
- Reduce the risk and do not let anyone else into your support bubble. Stop all non-essential contact with people you don't live with
- Reduce the risk, avoid car sharing with people not in your household

- Food shopping
- A friendly phone call
- Urgent supplies e.g. medication
- Other issues...just contact.

The Hub hotline is open between 09:00 and 16:00 Monday to Friday and between 09:00 and 12:00 on Saturdays.

This fantastic support network continues to be there for our residents, and I would urge anyone who is worried to get in touch so we can all get through this together

This latest lockdown will be tough for us all, arguably tougher than the first after months of restrictions and as we head into winter. But stopping the spread of coronavirus has to be everyone's top priority at this time. It is essential that we all follow the restrictions so the rate of transmission drops and we can get back to the things we love sooner.
