

Roll Out of Corona Virus Vaccinations



I've been asked many times – when will I be getting my 'Jab' as most know there is a set rollout criteria by the Government and Public health England – See below....

Locally I know a good number of residents over 80 have been vaccinated at Peterborough City Hospital, several have been lucky enough to have had (2) doses.

As far as I am aware – the Covid - Co-ordinators are presently looking for suitable venue's in Fenland and Whittlesey.

Some sites have been suggested, bearing in mind of being compliant with Covid regulations, i.e. one way in and one way out of a building.

Initially a venue/facilitator (Chemists for example) have to be able to give at least 1,000 vaccinations a week – that's 200 a day on a 5 day week – around 20 an hour.

That is a big task – I understand as more vaccine becomes available, PHE will look for more localised smaller venues.

As far as local Nursing Homes residents are concerned – I am unable to find out as this would be confidential information.

If I get any update – naturally I will post up as soon as I am aware.

Vaccine priority list

- 1 Residents in a care home for older adults and their carers
- 2 All those aged 80 and over. Frontline health and social care workers
- 3 All those aged 75 and over
- 4 All those aged 70 and over. Clinically extremely vulnerable individuals
- 5 All those aged 65 and over
- 6 All individuals aged 16-64 with underlying health conditions which put them at higher risk of serious disease and mortality
- 7 All those aged 60 and over
- 8 All those aged 55 and over
- 9 All those aged 50 and over
