

£500 grant



available to help people self-isolate

A £500 lump sum is available to those who are unable to work from home and will lose income by self-isolating.

Anyone who tests positive for Covid-19, or has been told they have been in contact with someone who has, now has a legal duty to self-isolate. Those that don't risk a fine.

You can claim if you meet the following criteria:

- 1 Have been told to self-isolate by NHS Test and Trace because you have tested positive for Covid-19 or have been in close contact with someone who has
- 2 Are unable to work, on a low income and receiving benefits
- 3 Will lose income; and will struggle to pay bills or buy food.

NHS Test and Trace notification, bank statement, and proof of employment or self-assessment returns will need to be provided. Payment is sent within 3 working days.
