I am writing in my personal capacity to object to the application by Jakub Transport for a Goods Vehicle Operator's Licence operating out of The Old Barn, Ramsey Road, Whittlesey, Peterborough PE7 2AA

The reasons for objection as follows :-

The B1040 is already stressed in respect on HGV movements.

This 'B' road build in the early 1900's was never designed to handle large volumes of HGV's. Limited width of the road at the St Andrews Church causes HGV's to clip the curb and path, this is both dangerous to pedestrians and mobility scooter users.

There has been historic meetings by residents with Councillors, in respect of both HGV's, Parking and Speeding concerns.

The road sometimes becomes 'jammed' when 2 HGV's are trying to navigate in opposite directions.

The proximity of the Ramsey Road Railway Crossing, if the operator intends vehicles to turn left onto Ramsey Road there is limited visibility, vehicles approaching the level crossing are still travelling at speed as the 30 mph limit is on the other side of the crossing.

HGV's are already a source of vibration which residents have complained about, some houses are less than 1.5 metres from the side of the road.

More HGV movements on this road is not conducive to climate change, noise, pollution or particulates entering the atmosphere.
