NOTICE is given that Cambridgeshire County Council has made an Order pursuant to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, the effect of which is to stop any vehicle from parking / waiting along Queen Street, Whittlesey as lies between Market Street and The Maltings.

During the period this order remains in force Cambridgeshire County Council (Queen Street, Whittlesey) (Street Parking Places) Order 2015 Street Parking Places Mondays to Saturdays inclusive between the hours of 8am to 6pm maximum stay 1 hour no return with 1 hour is hereby suspended insofar as it affects Queen Street Whittlesey on its west side from a point 14 metres north of its junction with Market Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 49 metres and East side from a point 16 metres north west of its junction with Market Street in a northerly direction for a distance of 21 metres.

The Order is made to facilitate new gas connection works which are being carried out on or near this highway and it will come into operation on 17 January 2022 and continue until these works have finished or on the 16 July 2023 whichever is the earlier.

It is anticipated that these works will be carried out between 17 January and 21 January 2022.

The Order shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
