Dear Sir or Madam,

A47 Guyhirn junction improvements – resurfacing and bridge repair work

I am writing to let you know that we'll be carrying out resurfacing and bridge repair work for the next stage of our A47 Guyhirn scheme.

There will be five weekend closures (Friday evening until Monday morning) required to allow us to complete the works. We've agreed with Cambridgeshire County Council suitable diversion routes, as detailed below:

Where: A47 Fen Road will be closed between Guyhirn and Gull Road When: 8pm on Friday 18 February to 6am on Monday 21 February

8pm on Friday 25 February to 6am on Monday 28 February

Diversion route for Fen Road closure (shown in diagram one):

- Eastbound traffic will exit the Whitepost roundabout at Thorney onto the A1139, then continue onto A605 Fletton Interchange, take the slip road onto the A605 through Whittlesey and Coates to the A141, and re-join the A47 at Guyhirn.
- Westbound traffic will follow this diversion in reverse.

Where: All the approaches to the Guyhirn roundabout (South Brink, Fen Road,

and the A141 March Road south to the A605)

When: 8pm on Friday 11 March to 6am on Monday 14 March

8pm on Friday 18 March to 6am on Monday 21 March 8pm on Friday 25 March to 6am on Monday 28 March

Diversion route for Fen Road closure (shown in diagram one)

- Eastbound traffic will exit the Whitepost roundabout at Thorney onto the A1139, then continue onto A605 Fletton Interchange, take the slip road onto the A605 through Whittlesey and Coates to the A141, and re-join the A47 at Guyhirn.
- Westbound traffic will follow this diversion in reverse.



Diversion route for South Brink closure (shown in diagram two)

- Eastbound traffic will follow the A47 west to Peterborough and join the A16 north to Sutterton, then take the A17 east to King's Lynn, and re-join the A47 to return to Guyhirn.
- Westbound traffic will follow this route in reverse.

Diversion route for the A141 closure (**shown in diagram three**)

- Northbound traffic will take the A605 westbound through Whittlesey towards Peterborough, then take the A1139 and the A15 north to pass Peterborough, and then the A47 eastbound through Thorney to reach the Guyhirn roundabout.
- Southbound traffic will follow this diversion route in reverse.

We'd like to apologise for any disturbance caused by our works, we'll try to keep this to a minimum where possible.

If you're a resident and need access to and from your property, please call our Works Manager on 07923 259298 to be escorted through the closure. We'll make every effort to ensure quick access, although this may not be possible while particular work is being completed. Please keep this letter if access is required.

We're working hard to maintain the road network and are prioritising critical activities. All our sites have strict safeguarding measures, in line with Public Health England and construction industry guidance, to prevent the spread of COVID-19, and none of our sites are open to the public. 


Diagram 2: Diversion route for A47 South Brink closure
