Water efficiency	Rain water recycling, grey water reuse, paving or communal planting that prevents flooding
Wildlife	Creating habitats, protecting species, restoring communal green spaces for wildlife
Waste	Projects where the primary aim is to reduce waste or recycle waste
Transport	Car sharing, biodiesel vehicles, community cycling
Sustainable materials	Projects where the primary aim is to increase the use of sustainable materials
