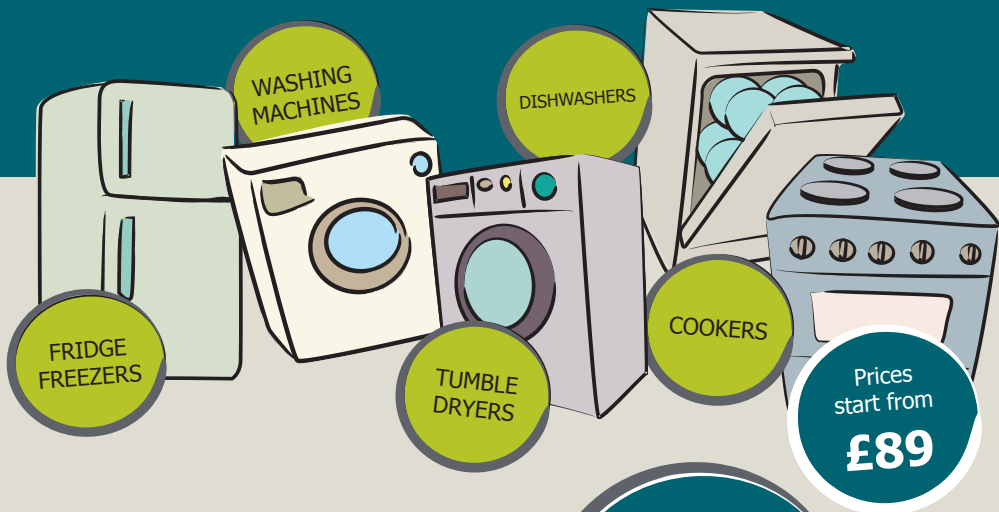


Do you need to buy an electrical appliance - big or small?

The shop is open from 9am - 3.30pm, Monday to Friday so pop along and have a look.

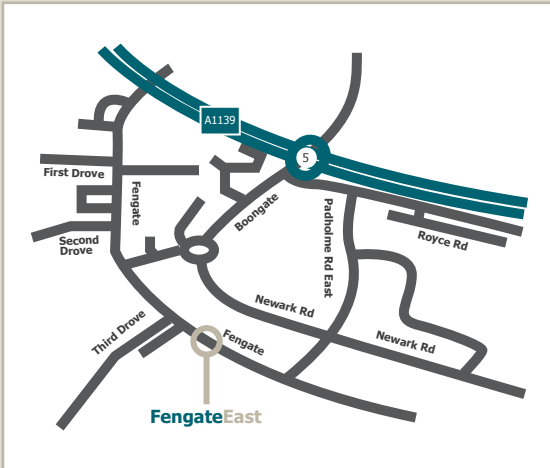
Electrical waste is the fastest growing waste stream in the UK increasing by 5% every year.

2 million working PCs end up in landfill sites in the UK every year.

Have you got an unwanted electrical item that has lost its spark?

Just bring your unwanted and broken electrical items to the WEEE Reuse Recycle Centre in Fengate (we do not pay for or collect items). Items are repaired or refurbished by competent engineers and resold in our shop, while those beyond repair are stripped down, with the good parts being re-used and the rest recycled.

We also accept waste electrical and electronic equipment from businesses, so please contact WEEE Re-use on **01733 425450** for more information.



Over 75% of waste electrical goods end up in landfill where lead and other toxins can cause soil and water contamination.

The main reasons for not recycling electrical items was lack of awareness. Firstly knowing what can be recycled (41%) and secondly knowing where to take items (25%).
