Name of Order:-

Cambridgeshire County Council (A605 Kings Delph, Whittlesey)
(Restricted Roads and 40mph Speed Limit) Order 202-

The Authority's reasons for proposing to make the above named Order(s) are as follows:-

- For promoting lower vehicle speeds and creating a safer environment for all road users.

Explanatory Note:-

The proposed 30mph speed limit will replace the existing 40mph limit through the main built-up part of Kings Delph. The characteristics of this length of road are more compatible with a 30mph speed limit. New gateway features will be installed that will emphasise to drivers the start of the lower speed limit. The remaining lengths of 40mph speed limit along this section of the A605 will be unchanged.

This speed limit change is supported by Whittlesey Town Council and is being funded through the County Council's Local Highway Improvement initiative.
