Dear Recipient,

Cambridgeshire County Council proposes to make an Order under all relevant sections of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be to introduce a 20mph speed limit on the following roads in Whittlesey:

The entirety of: Horsegate Ln, Horsegate, Park Ln, Boyce Cl, Love Ln, Duddington Gardens, Church St, Briggate West, Riverside Cl, Briggate East, Braemar Gardens, Briggate Cres, Ashline Gr, The Limes, Barr's St, London St, Parkinson's Ln, St Andrews Pl, Woolpack Ln, Paradise Ln, Falcon Ln, St Marys St, Turners Ln. As well as on: Hallcroft Rd from its junction with Park Ln, northwards for 20m; Priors Ln from its junction with Park Ln, westwards for 20m; Blackbush Drove from its junction with Briggate West, south-westwards for 44m; Ramsey Rd from its junction with Church St, southwards to a point 33m south of its junction with The Limes.
