Health & Safety / Risk Assessment Refresher Training

On 5th July, 6 volunteers from 4 street pride groups attended a refresher risk assessment training, kindly ran by Dawn, Senior Environmental Health Officer at FDC. Each attendee received a certificate of attendance and was treated to a light lunch.

The training was arranged as it is important that risk assessments are carried out before any event as managing safety enables you to put in place measures to reduce risks to acceptable levels. Groups should ideally be checking their risk assessment annually to make sure that it is still fit for purpose and refreshing it when there is a change to the activity, location or people taking part.

The course covered:

- Training and advice on the 5 Steps to an Effective Risk Assessment
- What the 5 Steps are
- Writing Risk Assessments
- Monitoring if the Risk Assessments are Effective
- When to Review a Health and Safety Risk Assessment

I hope those who attended feel they have the knowledge and confidence to be able to produce the necessary paperwork and be prepared for all future activities of their group.

If you feel that your group would benefit from attending this refresher training, please do not hesitate to get in touch. We can look to arrange another course, later this year.
