This year we are hosting the event at **Cambourne Village College**, starting at 9.30am with tea and coffee followed by talks from a range of speakers:

- Great Fen Great Future: Monitoring and Research Officer, Henry Stanier, will talk about what is so important about the Great Fen, how its wildlife is already benefiting from our work there, and, with the Peatland Progress project just beginning, what our hopes are for the future wildlife are the Fen.
- Senior Reserves Manager, Matt Hamilton, will explain how Cambourne has
 evolved from farmland, through building site, to the three villages and nature
 reserve it is today. He will focus on the wildlife that has benefitted from our
 close involvement in the planning and management of the developments and
 explain how it may evolve in future.
- We will also be joined by the Young People's Forum who will update us on what they have been up to over the last year so plenty to inspire you about the continued work of the Trust.
