(Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic)

Notice 23-1418

The County of Cambridgeshire hereby gives notice that from 08:00hrs on 18th October 2023, no vehicle shall proceed along Ramsey Road, Whittlesey as lies between The Limes and Cambers Drove.

Access will be maintained to properties affected by this Order.

The alternative route for vehicles is via Ramsey Road, Church Street, West End, Peterborough Road (A605), Ralph Butcher Causeway, Kings Dyke, Kings Delph, Toll Road, Milk And Water Drove and vice versa.

This Notice is made in the interest of safety because of emergency carriageway repairs and will remain effective whilst there is a risk of public danger but not for more than 21 days.

It is anticipated that these works will take place between 08:00hrs 18th October 2023 and 12:00 18th October 2023

The Notice shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
