I am very surprised NOT to have received complaints from Joggers or Doggies that the beastie crab had had a nip at them.

This sample here was large the body the size of a mans palm.

It had lost one of its 'claws' but was very active.

Under the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981, it is an offence to release or allow the species to escape into the wild in Britain. The Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs said it received reports of the crab in Cambridgeshire and it encouraged people to **report sightings to stop the movement of their eggs**.

The "**milky disease**" of the Chinese mitten crab, Eriocheir sinensis, is a highly lethal fungal disease caused by Metschnikowia bicuspidata infection
