St Mary's Church was built in 1854 but unfortunately had to be demolished in 1985 due to the uneven ground.

The replica is now a permanent feature within the closed Churchyard.

This project was made possible due to the generous support of FACT Mobile Community Hub and the 'Know Your Neighbourhood' Fund which is aimed at boosting volunteering opportunities and tackling loneliness.
