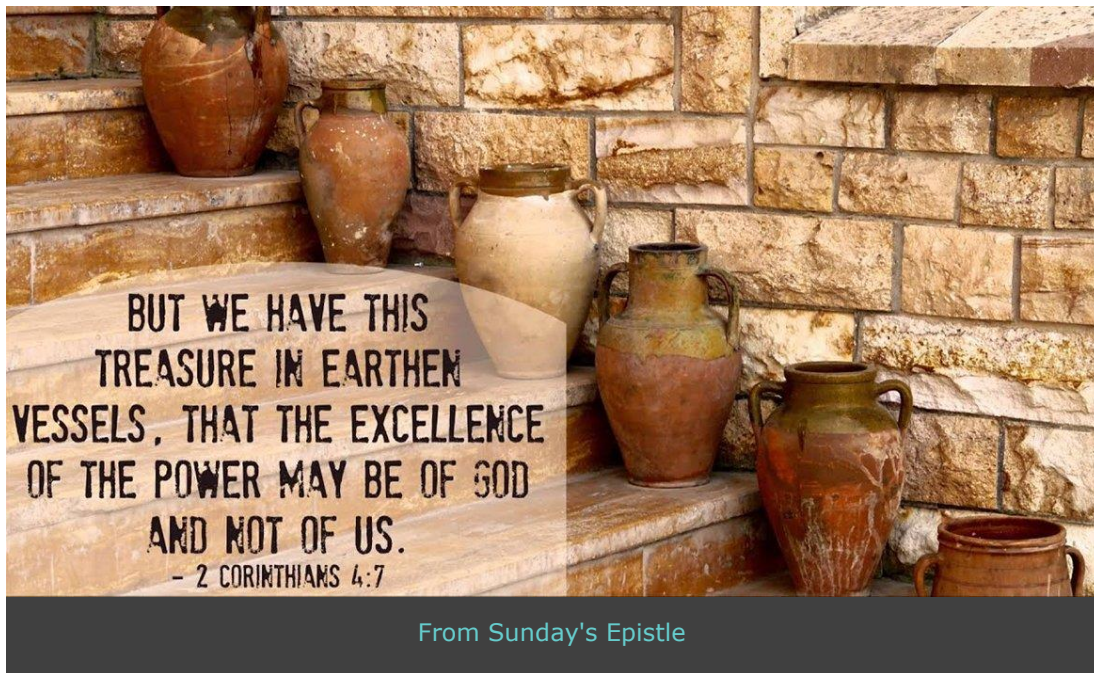


I hope you've all had a good half term! There's a fair few things happening this week, so do take some time to have a read of this weekly mailing.
