Public Forum: **Mr. Patrick Nightingale** :- Ongoing restrictions/traffic lights on the A605 What is WTC doing about it?

Mr. Steve Robertson: - Could members/councillors please speak up when talking.

Mr. R. Windle: The official opening of The Manor Fishing Platforms (14) at 11:00am on 27th July, local dignitaries and public are invited. The 2025 BIG BASH is dated for 22nd June.



Mr. A. Bessant: - Meetings with Multi-Agencies regarding Saxon Pit.

Mr. P Nightingale :- Continuous issues of traffic lights and lane restrictions on the A605 What are WTC doing about it?.

Items for discussion: Item agenda - Weeds - Cllr Boden (This was also on the agenda at Fenland District Council's meeting on Monday with a similar resolution being sent to Cambs CC. Cllr Boden reiterated the ongoing issues with 'weeds' throughout all of Fenland and Cambs, since the Rainbow Alliance Council at Cambs CC decided not to use weed spray last year. Weeds are now very well established and are seeding.

Informed that a spray of the weeds will take place in October which has been pointed out as being of no use. Councils use **Glyphosate** as the normal weed killer.

RG Note: We are somewhat lucky here in Whittlesey where we have 2 or 3 Volunteers going around hoeing around the town centre to make thing a big more presentable.

Relief Road – Cllr D. Laws :- The Outline Business Case – through Growing Fenland is still ongoing.


The meeting concluded at 19:15 a short meeting.
