how to hear God a simple guide for normal people PETE GREIG Nothing could possibly matter more than learning to discern the authentic voice of God, but few things in life are more susceptible to delusion, deception and downright abuse. When life falls apart and we need God's comfort; in moments of cultural turmoil when we need God's clarity; facing formidable decisions when we need God's guidance; desiring a deeper faith when we need God to say something, anything, to turn the monologue we call prayer into a genuine conversation.

Exploring the story of Christ's playful, poignant conversation on the road to Emmaus, Pete draws deeply from the insights of a wide range of Christian traditions. He weaves together the evangelical emphasis upon hearing God in the Bible, and the charismatic commitment to hearing God in the prophetic, with the contemplative understanding of God's 'still, small voice' within.

Some of us will be reading Pete Greig's 'How to Hear from God: a simple guide for normal people' over the summer. We'll be meeting on alternate Thursday evenings to discuss what we've read and to explore Hearing from God a little bit more. We'll be meeting at the Rectory at 7pm to discuss:




