The alternative route for vehicles is via B1040 - A47 - A141 - A605 and vice versa.

This Notice is made in the interest of safety because of emergency sheet piling and resurfacing of carriageway and embankment and associated works and will remain effective whilst there is a risk of public danger but not for more than 21 days.

It is anticipated that these works will take place between 00:00hrs 28 October 2024 and 23:59 22 November 2024

The Notice shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
