You should have received an Alert from the police about Hare Coursing. Although this does not mention Whittlesey the areas around us are an attraction to these people. Please note and report any unusual activity that might be related to Hare Coursing to the police but take care over your own safety and you are advised not to approach anyone involved.

On many occasions criminals are caught as the result of people reporting events even though they are not near the actual crime scene. A case in point being the recent theft of the minibus from the Community Hub at Feldale. In the middle of the night recently if you saw a vehicle towing a minibus or even had footage on a camera this could be the missing piece of evidence the police need to solve the crime.
