In this Sunday's Gospel we hear of the miraculous catch of fish in Luke 5 after Simon's exasperation that they have been fishing all night and caught nothing (!) but Jesus tells them to put down their net on the other side.

Some of you might remember that I chose this Gospel for our very first service here in the Benefice, following a vision that God had given me. As I now prepare to move on later in March, my hope - as you hear this Gospel again on Sunday - is that you might be able to hear Jesus' voice in all you do as church, and most importantly - that, like Simon, you might have the courage and trust to follow his voice and obey his will - however uncomfortable that may feel or as crazy as it might sound.

Jesus is Lord. Let us put our faith in him, and like Simon, may we as church always be ready to take that leap of faith and put down our nets on the other side - or better yet, to even step out of the boat and follow our Lord onto the water when he calls.
