

Please 'Think' Before You Vote – Please Do It

Cambs County Council Elections 01st May – Whittlesey South Ward

Many would have received election material through their letter box by now, and postal votes have been sent out.

As you may be aware I am not standing as a County Councillor.

Me and fellow 'Independents' in Whittlesey are supporting Cllr Barry Wainwright who we think is the best local candidate'

I would not wish to derail Barry's electioneering and these comments are written by me.

Lets get some 'facts and figures around Dr Haq Nawaz electioneering campaign.

1/ Dr Haq tried to get selected and elected in Peterborough for the best part of 10 years – it never happened – Ask Peterborough ex Councillors John Peach, John Holdich and others why?

2/ Dr Haq comes to Whittlesey with a great deal of 'political campaigning experience' Friends with Borris and Stanley – excellent a 'strategic levels'.
Door knocks and a hard campaigner – but know's very little about Whittlesey – but claims too.

3/ One of Dr Haq's first projects was he wanted a Flag Pole' at the Council Offices, He was tasked with it – 6 months later we were presented with '2' Flag Poles at a cost of **£4,000+** - He insisted that was a good price and VFM (value for money). Eventually I was tasked with the job and got the whole thing done with fitting and flag for **£250:00** – just one of his 'strategic examples'

4/ Lets have a look at 'Planning' Dr Haq has had 'some training' in planning and S106 agreements, how much he has remembered is somewhat subjective.
Again campaigning and 'spinning' people's emotions, make a big noise about the proposed development in Coates. What Dr Haq has forgotten is National Planning Policy Framework, and the 'Local Plan' – we all are very sensitive to larger planning applications and how the impact and affect us.

5/ It was Dr. Haq who introduced 2 Peterborough residents who were elected to WTC and play very little part in Whittlesey issues – but go around door knocking and campaigning.

6/ So let us look at Dr Haq’s attendance at WTC Planning meetings – **less than 50%** attendance....not good, and only **this week** a major application for ‘Drybread Road’ now at the ‘reserved matters stage’ he was absent.
