



MVV Medworth CHP - local liaison and communications

As you may be aware, there is an ongoing **Community Liaison Group (CLG)**, which meets each month at the Oasis Community Centre. The CLG is supported and attended by MVV but is co-ordinated and run by its own membership, via the Chair (Ginny Bucknor) and Vice-Chair (Alan Wheeldon).

The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday 16th April, 6-8pm

For clarity, there are a further two groups being set up.

1. A **Local Business Liaison Group (LBLG)** which, as the name suggests, will be a forum for questions and concerns to be addressed for those employers, manufacturers and other companies in the vicinity of the construction site and/or eventual facility. Equally, it will be a means by which MVV will communicate more geographically-focused aspects to that discrete audience. The catchment essentially relates to roads leading to, or in the proximity of, Alorges Way but the aim is to have open discussion, rather than to limit the 'membership'. These meetings have yet to be established but are expected to be run by/for the group itself – as with the CLG. However, MVV will provide support and we are keen involve the prospective audience in deciding the format, venue, invitation list, timings, etc.
2. Additionally, there is an **Operator Led Liaison Group (OLLG)**. This is a more formal meeting, on an invitation-only basis, for relevant statutory bodies and key stakeholders but including representation from the other two groups.
