

Saxongate News Update.

The meeting date when planning application CCC/24/091/VAR (The Johnsons Aggregates Recycling Ltd IBA/A expansion) will be considered has not been officially confirmed.

Saxongate has been informed it is likely to be the 16/07/25. Failing that it would be the 10/09/25, both starting at 10am. The meeting will be at Alconbury New Shire Hall and there will be a video link. We are checking if Councillors Gill and Dr Nawaz are still able to provide a minibus to help some of us attend and witness the meeting in person. It is open to the public. Saxongate will endeavour to speak but the time is very limited.

Our MP Stephen Barclay raised Saxon Pit and issues with the EA in a debate at Westminster this week. [Environment Agency criticised over Whittlesey pollution incidents - BBC News](#) "He urged the government to examine the body's "lack of transparency and accountability on its operational performance". He also mentioned the failure of the EA to issue a permit for trade effluent being pumped into the Kings Dyke from Saxon Pit.
