I write in connection with your request for information received on 31st July. I note you seek access to the following information:

The A605, between the Cardea Roundabout (Stanground Bypass) and the roundabout at the junction of Dandelion Drive and the A605 in Whittlesey has several sections of road covered by averaging speed cameras.

Please supply figures for the following:

- 1. The number of vehicles recorded at speed at or greater than 10% + 2mph greater than the posted speed limit**
- 2. The number of Notices of Intended Prosecution (NIPs) issued for those instances recorded at point 1**
- 3. The number of instances recorded at point 1 where the driver was offered a speed/safety awareness course as an alternative to prosecution**
- 4. The number of instances recorded at point 1 where a fixed penalty notice was issued**
- 5. the number of instances recorded at point 1 where the matter was dealt with through the courts**
- 6. The number of instances recorded at point 1 where no further action was taken.**

Please break these figures down for each discrete section of averaging speed cameras, in westerly and easterly directions, for each of the past three years
