The Environmental Health Team have been very busy in the town of Whittlesey and the surrounding villages over the past month.

There were ten planning consultation responses for the Whittlesey area during October and Environmental Health colleagues continue to liaise with personnel from other agencies regarding Saxon Pit activities.

We are investigating the 2 fly tips found in Whittlesey and the persons of interest have been invited to participate in a formal interview under caution.

Abandoned and Nuisance vehicles.

Street Scene received 19 reports of vehicles being abandoned this month, 2 of which were in Whittlesey. Both were issued nuisance notices, allowing the owners to contact us, when contact was made, they were advised that they need to move their vehicle from a private car park and further away from a junction. This saw the cars moved.

Open Spaces

Tivoli are on target with the grass cutting this year, with the last cut of the season commencing w/c 21st October 2025. Over the winter months, when the operatives work reduced hours, the team will be concentrating on maintenance of hedges, shrubs and hard surfaces.

Work completed in October includes:

- Reduce elder in Churchfield Way open space
- Trim hedge at Horsegate Lane
- Clear vegetation from brick outbuilding at Manor

- Remove brambles at perimeter of Diana Close open space
- Repair to play equipment at Manor
