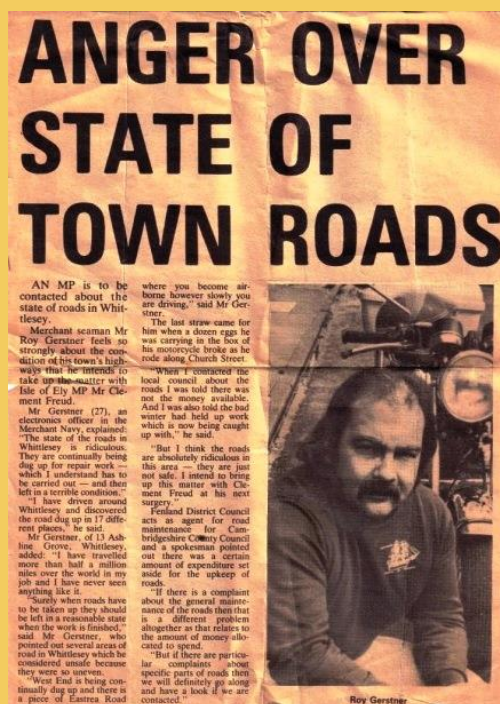
Someone will always say, 'we' only ever see or hear from you at election time.
