What is happening?

From March 2026, you can take part in free adult cycle training sessions across Fenland. We'll be visiting locations in Wisbech, Chatteris, Whittlesey and March.

You can choose from one-to-one or small group sessions. Everything is tailored to your ability and what you want to learn.

Whether you want to get started, build your confidence, or feel safer on the roads, you'll be supported at every step.

Who is the training at?

The training is for you if you:

- Haven't cycled before
- Feel nervous about cycling
- Want extra support to build confidence
- Would benefit from accessible and inclusive sessions

The sessions are free. A bicycle will be provided, or you can bring your own if preferred.

What experience level is this aimed at?

You can take part whatever your experience level.

You might be a complete beginner. Or you might already cycle but want to feel more confident on the road.

You can book the session that feels right for you, and everything will be adapted to your individual needs.
