Vehicle Nuisance calls include:

- Multiple reports of illegal or inconsiderate parking
- 1x report of drunk driving
- 2x report of off-road vehicles being used on the highway

Poaching calls:

- All three poaching calls were attended by police. One of these poaching incidents was discovered to be a legal shoot.

Shoplifting:

- One of the shopliftings has been closed, while the other remains under investigation.

Burglary:

- Of the three burglaries, two remain under investigation with the third having been filed.
- One of these burglaries is a theft from shop – i.e. shoplifting. As the suspect has previously been banned from the store, it can be classified as burglary rather than shoplifting.

March NPT Activity:
