(Temporary Prohibition of Through Traffic)

Notice 2026-21640

The County of Cambridgeshire hereby gives notice that from 08:00hrs on 2nd September 2026, no vehicle shall proceed along Turningtree Road, Whittlesey as lies between Glassmoor Bank and Whittlesey Footpath 44.

Access will be maintained to properties affected by this Order.

The alternative route for vehicles is via Turningtree Road, Station Road, Scaldgate, Market Street, Queen Street, Barrs Street, Parkinsons Lane, London Street, Church Street, Ramsey Road, Glassmoor Bank (C67) and vice versa.

This Notice is made in the interest of safety because of emergency carriageway repairs and associated works and will remain effective whilst there is a risk of public danger but not for more than 21 days.

It is anticipated that these works will take place between 08:00hrs 2nd September 2026 and 16:00 2nd September 2026

The Notice shall not apply to any persons lawfully engaged in connection with any works for which it is made, any member of the Police Force, Fire and Rescue Service, Ambulance Service, a vehicle being used by Special Forces during the execution of their duties or to any person acting with the permission or upon the direction of a Police Officer in uniform.
