Any questions that cannot be answered live will be followed up after the event and questions and answers from the sessions will also be collated and published online.

The final report will be published online on 7th October and will be available to everyone at the same time.

Each information session will last approximately one hour. Both sessions will cover the same information, so you only need to attend one.
